

Nock-A-Mixon Packing List 2012

- [] 12 T-Shirts make 2 blue and 3 gold (for Color War)
- [] 10 Shorts (any color)
- [] 2 Sweatshirts
- [] 4 Sweatpants or jeans
- [] 12 Underpants
- [] 14 Pair of socks
- [] 4 Sleepwear (including boxer shorts)
- [] 4 Swimsuits
- [] 1 Lightweight jacket
- [] 1 Hooded raincoat, poncho or waterproof jacket (required)
- [] 2 Baseball hats

Bedding/Linens and Packing

- [] 2 Blankets or 1 blanket or comforter and sleeping bag
- [] 4 Cot-sized sheets (72 x 30) (2 flat pref.) (2 fitted)
- [] 2 pillow cases
- [] 1 Pillow
- [] 10 Bath towels
- [] 1 Laundry bag
- [] 1 Duffel bag, canvas or nylon
- [] 1 soft trunk

Footwear

- [] 2 Pairs Sneakers
- [] 1 Pair rubber flip flops

Toiletry Articles

- [] 2 Toothbrushes, toothpaste, drinking cup, comb or brush, soap, soap dish, nail clipper, shampoo, tissues, toothbrush holder (please use all plastic containers.)
- [] Shower Caddy

Optional

- [] All-purpose cleats (soccer), roller blades and protective equipment (wristbands, elbow pads, helmet), fishing rod (with barbless hooks only), lacrosse stick, hockey stick, swim goggles, sports mouth guard, hockey gloves, tennis racquet and balls, pickle ball racquet and balls.

Required Sports Equipment for Boys and Girls

- [] Soccer shin guards, hockey helmet with cage (NOT required for girls completing grades 1-4) baseball glove, shatter-proof athletic glasses (where applicable)

Other Items

- [] Extra batteries for games, cameras & radios, flashlight, pens, stationery, extra pair of glasses, pre-addressed post cards & envelopes (for younger campers), sunscreen, and pre-paid phone card

Special Clothing

- [] 1 Masquerade costume (Girls only)
- [] 1 Nice casual outfit for cabaret dance

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Expensive jewelry, clothing and games, candy, gum or any other food, television, hot pots plug in radios and fans, pen knives, Cell Phones, DVD players/PG-13 and R rated movies walkie talkies, lawn chairs, or EXCESSIVE CLOTHING, NO ELECTRIC FANS.

Special Instructions

1. To prevent loss, all articles of clothing and equipment must have campers name.
2. Name should be put on clothing worn by campers to camp and on extra articles carried on the bus.

Nock-A-Mixon has a Laundry on camp grounds. New red clothing that has to be laundered should not be sent to camp, as well as other colors that tend to run. We have found that laundry markers are often inadequate, as they will fade on clothing washed weekly. Use name tapes whenever possible.
