

# Suggested Packing List of Clothes & Items

1. Your child's clothing is laundered once a week. It is picked up one day and will be returned the next day. You should provide approximately 10 days worth of clothing and several days extra in the event that unusual circumstances occur.
2. Use this check-off list as a guide. Adjustments should be made to provide for your child's individual interests and needs. Our washers and dryers are commercial machines. **Do Not Send delicate clothing that cannot be sent to the camp laundry.**
3. Luggage is transported to camp with your child. Please use only duffel bags or soft suitcases. No hard trunks. (Limit two per camper.)
4. Some families choose to ship their child's luggage. Please contact [www.campshippers.com](http://www.campshippers.com) who is our shipper. Alternatively, if you still choose to ship yourself, please make sure to put your child's name on the boxes.
5. Remember everyone tends to overpack - try not to.
6. **All clothing, shoes, linens, equipment, electronics, instruments and cords etc. should be labeled with the camper's FULL name. NO INTITALS.** We do not know your child's middle name. Last summer there were 26 Samanthas and 32 Max's; 4 Madison C.'s.

**NOTE:** Campers should also bring items relative to their major areas of interest, e.g.. Musicians bring their instruments, tennis players bring their racquets, skateboarders bring their skate board etc. Anyone intending to be in a show should have one "dress" outfit with tie, suit, black shoes, black socks, dress, etc.

**Equestrians:** For safety reasons we have three strict clothing rules. Riders are expected to wear long pants while on the horse (jeans are perfect). Smooth-sided shoes with heels are a must for fitting into the stirrups (no sneakers). If your child does not have a riding hat, we have an assortment of sizes for him/her to pick from and wear.

**ALSO:** Bring lots of white T-shirts, these are great for silkscreen, tie-dye and a million other uses at camp.
